## Definitions for Family Reunion travel under section 5 of the *Parliamentary Business Resources*Act 2017 and sections 4 and 6 of the *Parliamentary Business Resources Regulations* 2017

**Family member** of member means any of the following:

- (a) the member's spouse or nominee;
- (b) a dependent child of the member;
- (c) a designated person in relation to the member.

**Spouse** of a member, includes **de facto partner** within the meaning of the Act Interpretation Act 1901 (AIA Act). Section 2(D)(C)(F) of the AIA Act provides that a person is the de facto partner of another person, whether of the same sex or a different sex, if:

- (a) the person is in a registered relationship with the other person; or
- (b) the person is in a de facto relationship with the other person, that is, the persons:
  - (i) are not legally married to other and;
  - (ii) are not related by family; and
  - (iii) have a relationship as a couple living together on a genuine domestic basis.

**Nominee**, in relation to a member, means a person nominated by the member in place of a spouse.

**Dependent child** of a member means a person in relation to whom:

- (a) both of the following apply:
  - (i) the person is less than 16;
  - (ii) the member is legally responsible (whether alone or jointly with another person) the day-to-day care, welfare and development of the person; or
- (b) both the following apply:
  - (i) the person is less than 16 and less than 18;
  - (ii) the person is financially dependent on the member; or
- (c) all the following apply:
  - (i) the person is 18 or older;
  - (ii) the person is financially dependent on the member;
  - (iii) the person is undertaking, and has been continuously undertaking, secondary education.

**Designated person**, in relation to a member, means an individual nominated by the member for the purposes of this definition who:

- (a) is a member of the member's immediate family or extended family; or
- (b) is substantially dependent on the member; or
- (c) has signification caring responsibilities for:
  - (i) the member's spouse or nominee, or dependent child; or
  - (ii) another person who is substantially dependent on the member.
