

Members of Parliament (Staff) Act 1984

TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE ARRANGEMENTS UNTIL 30 JUNE 2021

I, MATHIAS CORMANN, Minister for Finance, for and on behalf of the Prime Minister, determine under subsections 13(2) and 20(2) of the *Members of Parliament (Staff) Act 1984* that, with effect on and from the date of this determination:

1. If an employee whose travel is not subject to the electorate support budget has had 120 overnight stays in Canberra in the 2020-21 financial year, the employee will be paid an amount equivalent to the Canberra rate of travelling allowance relevant for the employee's classification for any further overnight stays in Canberra until and including 30 June 2021.
2. If an employee:
 - (a) whose travel is not subject to the electorate support budget; and
 - (b) whose work base is neither Canberra nor an office of the employing Senator or Member provided at Commonwealth expensehas had 120 overnight stays in Canberra or the location of an office of the employing Senator or Member provided at Commonwealth expense in the 2020-21 financial year, the employee will be paid an amount equivalent to the rate of travelling allowance relevant to the location and the employee's classification for any further overnight stays in:
 - (c) Canberra; or
 - (d) the location of an office of the employing Senator or Member provided at Commonwealth expenseuntil and including 30 June 2021.
3. This determination revokes on 30 June 2021.
